### Student Material List

#### **Paper**

- tissue papers – plain, patterned, old pattern tissue - whatever you have.
- old sheet music
- pages from an old book including text and drawings
- paper napkins
- a pad of A4 cartridge paper
- a sketchbook

#### **Fabric**

- an assortment you might have including spots, stripes, flowers, words
- maybe some laces and other bits and pieces like tiny buttons or ric rac
- felt or craft vilene

#### **Colour**

- oil pastels (if you have them)
- paints a small selection including black and white (if you have them)
- white gesso
- paint brush and water container
- stencil brush

#### **General**

- sewing machine and accessories including a darning foot for free machine work
- sewing machine needles Topstitch size 90 or 100
- small sharp scissors
- scissors for paper and fabric
- machine threads – assorted but include black machine thread
- vliesofix (fusible webbing) – approx 2 metres (don't get steam a seam – it should be paper backed fusible webbing)
- Waterproof black pen such as a micron or posca or sharpie
- Baking paper (bring a roll)
- Matt medium and a brush and water container
- palette knife (cheap plastic one is fine)
- disposable gloves (if you don't like getting glue on your fingers)
- masking tape
- heat gun (if you have one)

- an iron (a travel iron is fine)
- a firm surface to iron on
- Also – I haven't mentioned hand stitching – you may wish to in which case bring threads and needles.
