Student Material List

******Don't pack in the whole Kitchen!**

- Mannequin for experimental drape and fittings
- Denim, Denim and Denim - Jeans, Jackets, shirts...anything, any colour!
- 2.5 metres soft drapable fabric for skirt or pants or tunic etc
- Assorted titbits - *eg floral shapes to appliqué, tartans for trims etc*
- Some items to include in your search are couple of Ties, men's business shirts, sweatshirts, jumpers and knitwear - whatever takes your fancy.

- 1mtr. Water soluble fabric eg: Vilene 541 or Solvy
- Minimum 1mtr Iron-on Interfacing Whisperweft or similar (*black or white depends on fabric choice.*)
- 1mtr. Vliezofix
- 1 mtr. Tear-away or Stitch and Tear
- Thread for decorative stitching - Yarns or cords for bobbin work

Optional Extra's:

- Piping cord - width and length is a variable.
- Buttons- Lots could look interesting
- Zippers. Beads

*****Extra optional bits for the hoarders:**

- Big Knitting needles or crochet hook eg size 10
- Bias Making 'Gadget' – I know some of you have those in your tool kit!
- Chenille Fabric cutter

Basic Sewing Needs and Requirements:

- ***Note:** please bring along safety glasses.

Power board and/or extension cord.

Iron

Masking tape to tape down extension cords for safety.
Gladbake or Teflon mat

Electric Sewing Machine Cleaned and oiled.

All its equipment, instruction book, spare bobbins,
Flat bed.

Free Machining/ Darning foot
If unfamiliar, ask at a sewing centre,

both ESSENTIAL.

Applique Foot.

suitable for your model machine.

***Bring all your machine feet – here is the opportunity to play!

Sewing requirements.

Spare machine needles
(please include some large eye needles)
Eg. Metafil or Metallica 80
Or jeans, top stitch sizes 90-120,
Pins, dress making, small embroidery scissors,
paper scissors.
Chenille needle: large eye - suitable for crochet
cotton
Tailors chalk

Lots of Paper for pattern construction.

Sketch Book, pencil, rubber, ruler etc

Embroidery Hoop.

A narrow wooden hoop, screw adjustment type,
approx. 20cms in diameter.
Or a plastic “spring clip” style

Cottons and Threads:

Basic fabric colour,
Assorted decorative machine thread eg Madeira,

Simple Painting equipment (optional)

Stencil Brush or sponge
Plate/palette. Rag
Surgical Knife/ blade
Cutting Mat

* If you have a favourite Silk Screen and Squeegee bring that along

** I will bring some basic paint colours
